Community Safety - The Impact of Real and Perceived Increase of Crime

I have been wanting to write about community safety in Fargo for months but have avoided doing so for a number of reasons. I did not want to appear alarmist, judgmental, or intolerant. Safety and crime are topics discussed daily with my Arc coworkers at our downtown office. Our store donation bins and storage units are targeted multiple times per month at both thrift store locations. Common shoplifting occurs hourly and brazen grab and dash incidences are common and leave our employees fearful of the next event. Our employees are fearful walking to their vehicles after closing the store.

I have found myself avoiding Broadway, the panhandling has gotten more aggressive. One recent trip to grab lunch resulted in one person blocking my vehicle at a stop light while another began banging on my side window. When I refused to roll down my window- he began to punch my mirror, door, and window and screaming for me to comply. **Read on**

I would say go for it. Your dream is special because it's yours. Don't let people's low expectations stop you.

Do you think more people with disabilities should pursue starting businesses?

Yes, I do. A business can give you freedom and a way to show the world what you can do.

Have you ever felt like quitting? What made you keep going?

Yes, I have. Sometimes it's really hard. But then I think about the kids we serve and how happy they look. That always makes me keep going.

What do you think has made Spread Your Sunshine successful?

Kindness. People see we really care about kids and families, and they want to help us.

You have accomplished so much, do you have an even bigger dream?

Yes! My dream is to own my own restaurant one day.

Do you have any events coming up?

Yes, we have the Sunshine and Sprinkles Celebration this October 11th. It's a big family party with pizza, cake, games, and characters. Every penny goes back to helping kids and families.

What else do you want people to know?

I want people to know that every child deserves to feel loved, celebrated, and included. And anyone, no matter who you are, can help spread sunshine.
