What is the goal of ND Assistive?

We connect people to life-changing tools to help them live more independently.

What programs and services does your organization provide?

Assessments and Consultations - Whether you are an individual with a disability or someone providing care, we can help you find solutions to make things a little easier and more successful.

Equipment Programs - Our goal with our ND Assistive Demonstration Centers, located in Fargo and Bismarck, is to give you access to assistive technology equipment of all types, so you can know your options.

Specialized Phone Program - We provide specialized phones and equipment tailored to address hearing, visual, and cognitive challenges at no cost to qualifying individuals.

ICanConnect Deaf-Blind Service - Whether it's with friends, family, or the community, we're dedicated to making sure that no one feels isolated due to their hearing and vision loss.

Senior Safety Program - From installing bathroom grab bars to providing home monitoring equipment, our assistive technology transforms homes into secure havens for eligible North Dakotans over 60.

Assistive Technology Financial Loan Program - The North Dakota Assistive Financial Loan Program offers financial loans to help eligible individuals with disabilities acquire assistive technology (AT) they require.

Possibilities Grant - With the funds raised, we've been able to help eligible applicants purchase vision equipment, daily living aids, smart home devices, computer access tools, vehicle modifications, and more.

What if I don't have diagnosis documentation or a referral, can I still contact ND Assistive?

You do not need a referral to reach out to us. Anyone can call, email, or schedule an appointment.

We offer free services like center tours, group education and free assistive technology trials to help you find the right fit. While we don't sell anything, we'll connect you with trusted sources and funding options to obtain your device. We also produce webinars and videos on various assistive technology tools and topics.

Life Academy - Self Advocacy course that involves vision board planning. 4-6 weeks, one hour session per week

Self Advocacy Bingo - Bingo with a self advocacy theme; prizes included! One hour session

Interview Skills Training - Educational training about how to prepare for an interview. This is a partnership between The Arc and Job Service. Students will practice interviewing and receive feedback about their performance. One hour session

Practice Interviewing - Hands-on experience with interviewing at The Arc. Students will practice interviewing and receive feedback about their performance. One hour session

Virtual Reality Goggles - An opportunity for students to explore different professions by viewing virtual reality goggles. This is a partnership between The Arc and Job Service. One hour session

Educational Opportunities - Ongoing trainings about current issues and events affecting people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Join our programs list to hear about these opportunities!


